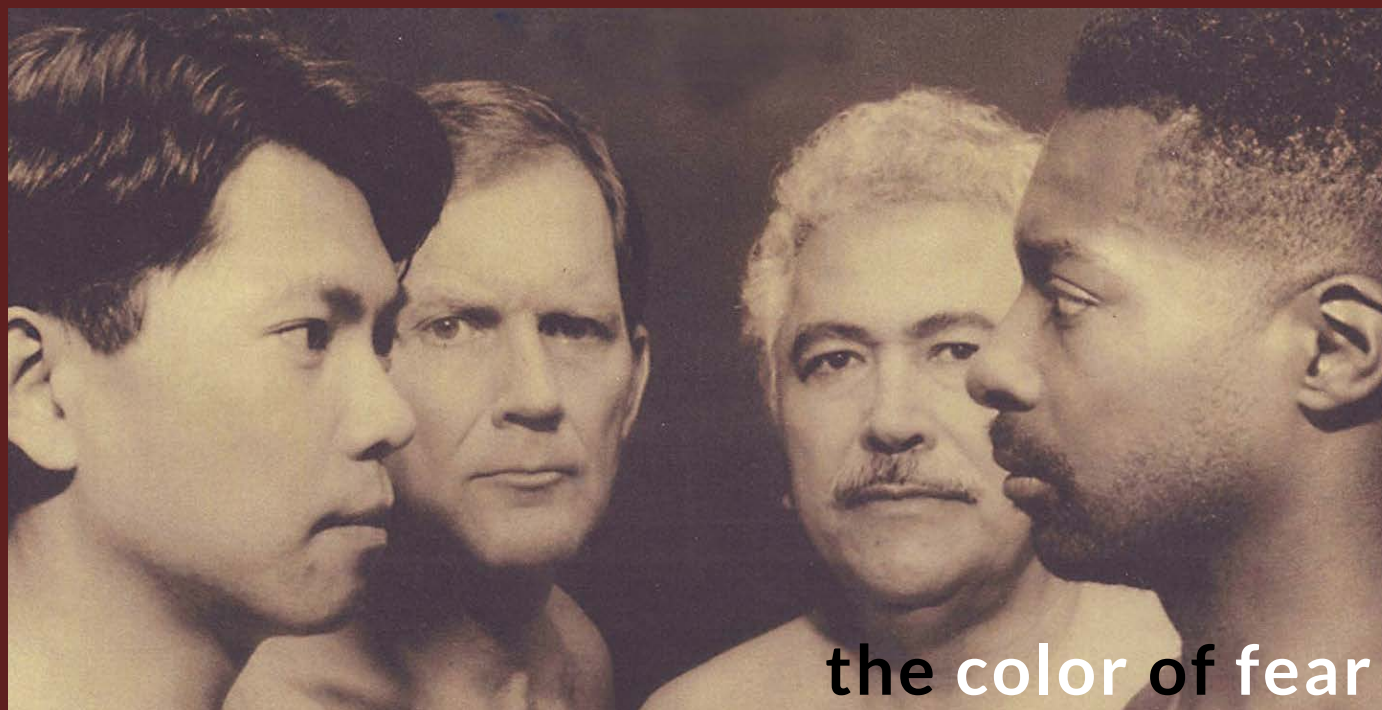


Diversity Week Film
